Since Eastern Washington upgraded its program to NCAA Division 1 in 1984, the two teams have played six games, all in Cheney. CWU has won two of the six. . .Eastern began playing basketball in Reese Court in the 1975-76 season. In that inaugural campaign, the Eagles posted an 11-3 homecourt record with all three losses administered by the 'Cats. Eastern followed that up with perfect 15-0 home records in both 1977 and 1978. . .CWU's all-time record at Reese Court is 6-11. Eastern's all-time record at Nicholson Pavilion is officially 8-26, including one win by forfeit. . .EWU's last visit to Ellensburg was in the 1982-83 season. . .Central and Eastern have played three overtime games, CWU winning a double overtime game at Cheney in 1931 and losing a triple overtime game at Cheney in 1976. Eastern won a single overtime game at Ellensburg in 1946.

Except for a pair of forfeit wins, the Clan lost their first 25 games at Nicholson Pavilion and have an all-time record of 1-29 in Ellensburg. Officially, the loss streak ended at 12 with the 1983 forfeit. . .CWU won five straight games at Burnaby between 1981 and 1985 and lost four straight between 1987 and 1990. The two teams have played two overtime games with CWU winning at Ellensburg in 1971 and at Burnaby in 1981 in the opening round of the NAIA District 1 playoffs. . .The total points and margin of victory in SFU's 100-71 win last season at Burnaby were high marks for the Clan in the series.
