MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF BOARD OF TRUSTEES
STATE NORMAL SCHOOL
ELLENSBURG
JANUARY 30, 1933

Those present were Mr. Wm. Yeaman, Mr. V. J. Bouillon, and President R. E. McConnell.

The following items of business were considered:

1. Letter from Governor Martin dated January 14 relative to salary reductions was read and discussed. The problems of the presidents of the five institutions as set forth in a letter to Governor Martin under date of January 17 was read and approved.
2. Dr. McConnell reported the cost of auditing which was completed in December, 1932.
3. A number of factors relative to the budget proposals and the nature of the requests to be made to the appropriations committees of the Legislature were discussed.
4. The following wage reduction was agreed upon:
35¢ labor should be reduced to 30¢ per hour.
Mrs. Lottie Lewis, cook, reduced from \$150 to \$135.
Mrs. Susie Hoveland, cook, reduced from \$90 to \$85.
5. President McConnell was authorized to investigate the cost of board and room, and if the dormitories can be run so as to pay expenses on a charge of \$26.00 per month, the price shall be reduced from \$7.00 to \$6.50 per week.
