LCSC lost 16 straight games at Nicholson Pavilion before finally winning a game on the CWU home court, which opened in the 1959-60 season, in 1989. The Warriors all-time record at the Pavilion is 5-25. .CWU's 21 point win last year in a non-conference game at Warrior Gymnasium was its biggest at Lewiston since a 30-point win in 1983, a victory it later forfeited. The Wildcats also won by 25 at Lewiston in 1980 and 27 in 1930. .Warrior coach George Pfeifer, in his 10th season, is 11-15 against CWU (7-5 at Lewiston, 4-8 at Ellensburg, 0-2 on neutral courts). Pfeifer is 5-8 against Sparling (3-3 at Lewiston, 2-4 at Ellensburg, 0-1 at Yakima).
