A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE OFFER OF THE UNITED STATES TO THE MASHINGTON STATE

NORMAL SCHOOL, ELLENSBURG, TO AID BY WAY OF GRANT IN FINANCING THE

CONSTRUCTION OF Auditorium, Classrooms, Shop and Equipment

Be it resolved by the Board of Trustees

Section 1. That the offer of the United States of America to the

Washington State Normal School, Ellensburg, to aid by way of grant in

financing the construction of Auditorium, Classrooms, Shop and Equipment

a copy of which offer reads as follows:

FEDERAL FMERGENCY ADMINISTRATION

OF PUBLIC WORKS

Washington, D. C. October 7, 1955

State of Washington, by and through the Board of Trustees of the State Normal School at Ellensburg, Ellensburg, Kittitas County, Washington.

Subject to the Rules and Regulations (PWA Form No. 179, July 22, 1885) as amended to date which are made a part hereof, the United St tes of America hereby offers to aid in financing the construction of a fireproof auditorium, class room and shop building and for the equipment thereof for the St to Normal School at Ellensburg by making a grant to State of Mashington, by and through the Board of Trustees of the State Normal School at Ellensburg (herein called the "Project") in the amount of 45 per cent of the cost of the Project upon completion, as determined by the Federal Emergency Administrator of Public Works, but not to exceed, in any event, the sum of \$105,500.

That the P<u>resident</u> be and he is hereby authorized and directed forthwith to send to the Federal Emergency Administration of Public Woks three certified copies of this Resolution and three certified copies of the proceedings of this <u>Meeting of the Board of</u> <u>Trustees</u> in connection with the adoption of this Resolution, and such further documents or proofs in connection with the acceptance of said offer as may be requested by the Federal Emergency Administration of Public Works.
