**RICHARD DANIELS**

Rick is co-captain with John Jurkovich on this year's eleven. Playing his fourth season now for the Lutes, Rick has been one of the outstanding guards on the team ever since he was a freshman. He has been on the starting lineup almost every year since he started. He switched to center on offense this fall because of the Lutes' need for more strength in that department. He is a definite candidate for All-Conference honors this year and should have a marvelous year for the Lutes. He played his prep ball for Lincoln in Tacoma.

Although Coaches Marv Tommervik and Marv Harshman will have 22 lettermen on hand this fall, they will have several green men in key positions. Nine of the lettermen are sophomores, several of whom saw only limited duty last season.

When turnouts began on September 1, a squad of 72 players greeted the coaches. In this group were some top-flight freshmen, six of whom played in the Tri-City vs. State All-Star high school game held in Seattle in August.



**LOWELL KNUTSON**

This is the fourth year that Lowell will be playing for PLC in the backfield. He is a hard runner and an accurate passer, throwing with his left hand. Although he does not have the speed of some of the other backs, he drives and hits hard and makes his share of yardage. In addition to being an outstanding athlete in three sports, he is president of the Associated Student Body this year. He played prep ball for Queen Anne in Seattle.

**ROBERT MACREADY**

Bob is another big, rangy tackle, standing about 6'5" and weighing almost 200. He is a bear on defense and should play a lot of football for the Lutes this year. He lettered '48, but last season he was not on the team.
