High school best in 200 fly is four seconds faster than CWU school-record. , including 100 butterfly finishing fourth in time of 59.82 after setting school record in preliminaries with time of 59.54. Also placed 11th in 50 free (25.19) and eighth in 100 back (1:01.49). Earned All-American honors on all five relay events as squad placed third in 200 free (1:39.48), third in 400 free (3:37.80), fourth in 800 free (8:03.69), second in 200 medley (1:49.40) and third in 400 medley (4:00.87). The latter two were school-record marks. Season-best marks of 25.13 in 50 free, 1:00.69 in 100 back, 59.54 in 200 back, 2:17.12 in 200 fly and 2:16.00 in 200 individual medley.
