Minutes of the meeting of the ADMINISTRATIVE COUNCIL held on June 22, 1956 in the President's Office

Present: Dr. Crum, Dr. McConnell, Dr. McGlasson, Mr. Mitchell, Dr. Mussall, Dr. Pettit, Mr. Rogel

The problem of facing a heavier load in professional service and a heavier instruction load was discussed at great length. It was agreed that the following steps should be taken in an attempt to improve conditions:

- Apply to the Governor for emergency funds for additional personnel.
- 2. Ask the Vancouver schools to carry on our student teaching program on the present arrangement with the understanding that college personnel will give them some additional help the beginning of the school year in assigning student teachers and orienting classroom teachers and student teachers to their assignments.
- Recommend to the Board of Trustees that we raise the liscellaneous Fee \$2.00 per quarter, beginning with the sutumn quarter, to cover additional costs of personnel, equipment and travel.
- Investigate the possibility of getting along with one less person in the Division of Science and Mathematics and the possibility of using graduate assistants for handling some sections of courses.
