Meeting was called to order 1:04 p.m.

The February 12, 2016 meeting minutes were approved as presented.

Student Senate SEOI video. Hauke presented some updated information on the video. The project has been pushed into Spring quarter.

SEOI publicity – The committee agreed it was okay to go with video and poster. Responses were mixed from the Executive Committee.

SEOI response rates - Tom gave the committee the 2015 SEOI response rates. The e-mail to students regarding the SEOIs will go out Monday. If faculty would allow tablets or phones in the classroom the students can download the App and do the SEOIs in class.

James will contact ITAM and Psychology about their response rates. Tom will send example of classes by instructor to Human Subjects committee to see if this type of data can be considered exempt. Tom indicated they are working on a gender bias study. Dr. Harrod is co-investigator on this study and some WGS students.

Tom indicated they have added an option for faculty that they could download all of the reports taught by a specific faculty member and can do a batch report. SEOI reports are now downloaded into Faculty 180 by academic year.

James asked if it is possible to pick up the top 50 faculty who have high response rates.
