4 I can't see him now because of a terrible accident for which my family blames the U.S. The plane had gone down, forcing him to eject. After he had hit the ground, some Vietnamese civilians had begun helping him. He might have ended up a POW (Prisoner Of War) but that would have been better than his ultimate fate. A U.S. plane dropped a mortar bomb, killing all. A Vietnamese reporter recalled the incident, for he took pictures of the deceased.
