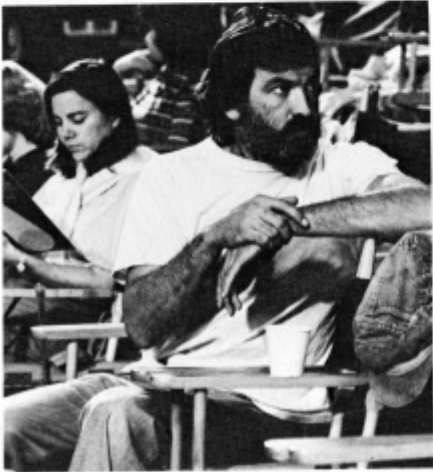

Good times, bad times, study times and those times that will never be forgotten. All part of college, and yet a life that is truly unique.







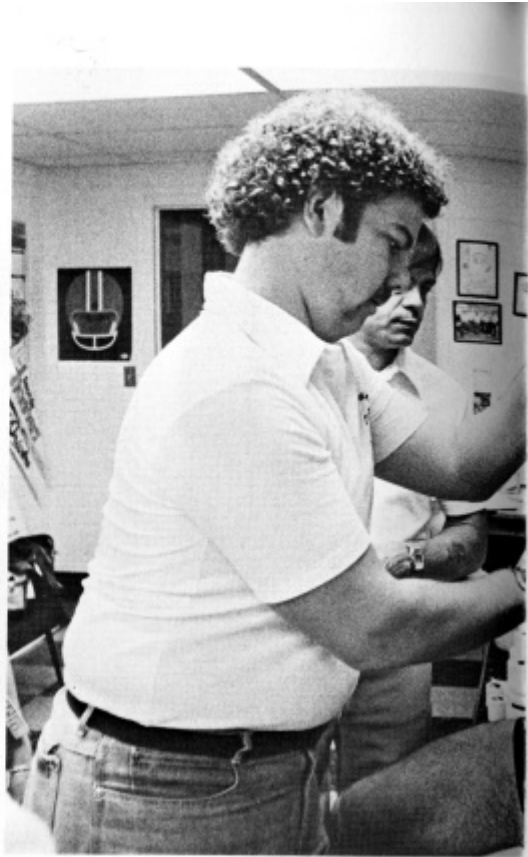
