RYAN PEPPER (6-3, Selah)

High School: Graduated from Selah Bible Baptist in 1991. Played for Selah High School. Earned three letters in basketball. Second team all-state senior season after earning all-conference honors.

College: Four-year lettermen and three-year starter for Wildcats. Pacific Northwest Athletic Conference Player-of-the-Year and second team All-American senior season. Set school single game (46), season (898) and career records (2254) for scoring, leading Wildcats to PNWAC title, 20-14 won-loss record and berth in NAIA national tournament. Also set career marks for field goals made (774), field goals attempted (1684), three-pointers made (263) and attempted (735), and minutes played (3865). Finished career third in scoring average (17.2), third in free throws made (443) and attempted (562), fifth in free throw percentage (78.8), fifth in assists (314), second in steals (261) and second in games played (131). Scored 30 or more points in career a school-record 16 times. . .Earned all-region and honorable mention All-American honors junior season when he averaged 20.2 points per game. . . .Averaged 8.0 points and had 57 assists and 52 steals freshman season. Ranked second on team in scoring to brother Jason sophomore year with 14.3 average. . Team MVP junior and senior season. Team captain sophomore year. Hustle award winner sophomore year.

Misc: Born 8-22-72 at Yakima. Played past three seasons in Australia. . . Has two brothers and two sisters. Sister Shana played two seasons of volleyball for CWU earning honorable mention All-America honors senior season. Older brother Jason was a first team All-American for CWU in 1992-93. Younger brother Redd played one season at CWU. Cousin Anysia is former standout volleyball player for CWU.
