Dear Carol + Ernest

July 4, 1959

Our wedding list was finally limited to aunts + uncle but I want you to know if you show up at Lutheran Church in Tacoma, July 18 by 8 P.M. you'll have no trouble getting admittance to see our Jack + his Sharon married. We hope mother will be here by then, + she plans to arrive next week – about 10th, we haven't heard Betty's plans but have hopes there too. We over the 17th to be present at rehearsal. Lots doing.

Wish you could see our Quincy area about now. About ready to start 2nd cutting hay, peas being harvested for freezing, seed peas to start harvest next week, some grain cut + more getting about + spuds are beautiful + in all stages. In fact a few about to be planted on the pea ground. We've been eating new spuds, some reds bigger than coffee cup and are nice and smooth but far from thru growing. Its some country-things later in Kittitas Valley but we love it here + its still home

We expect mother about the 10th. Will have her apartment in town again. Edna + Harold didn't think they could come now, we don't know about Betty + Law + don't expect Len either. I do think Betty + Law will come but nothing sure. Lots doing for us all of the time. Were in Seattle last Wednesday, home Thursday + I went back to Tacoma Friday for shower + weekend godabout for sure – must reen. Carolyn
