Started eight games for Wildcats last season Averaged 3.2 points and 3.4 rebounds. Had season highs of 11 points and 10 rebounds against Concordia on Jan. 5. Misc: Born 10-27-74 at Richland. Biology education major. Wants to teach biology and coach. Had 3.83 high school GPA, winning several academic scholarships. High School activities included honor society and Young Life group. Also worked with Toys for Tots and food bank. Has one brother and three sisters. Brother (John) played basketball at Boise State.

Scored career-high 24 points against Eastern Oregon on Dec. 3, 1994. Had career-high 14 rebounds on three different occasions during 1994-95 season. Listed in CWU Single Top 10 lists in four categories - first in blocks, sixth in rebounds, second in rebounding average and 10th in field goal percentage. Ranks second in career blocks, despite having played just one season. Sat out last season while attending Yakima Valley College. Misc: Born 7-20-76 at Yakima. Recreational management major. Has one brother. Was certified life guard at Yakima Tennis Club for three years.
