Casey Jacox (QB, 6-3, 200, Jr., Renton - Kentridge)

High School: Graduated from Kentridge in 1994. Earned two letters in football. Team captain. Honorable mention all-league junior season. Missed senior year after breaking four bones in right foot. College: Redshirted freshman year at CWU. Was No. 3 quarterback in 1995, completing his only pass attempt for minus one yard. Played in seven games last season starting three. Completed 74 of 145 passes for 888 yards and nine touchdowns. Completed 23 of 38 passes for 333 yards and four touchdowns in 44-41 loss to Pacific Lutheran to earn Wildcat-of-the-Week honors. .Has strong arm and has made good strides in knowledge of offense and leadership skills. Misc: Born 3-12-76 at Lacey. Business education major. High school activities included honor society and Natural Helpers. Coached youth league basketball. Has one sister. Cousin (James Compton) played football at UW.

Pete Kalasountas (QB, 6-3, 204, Fr., Renton - Hazen)

High School: Graduated from Hazen High School in 1996. Lettered in football (2) and baseball (2). Twice was selected all-league quarterback. Earned first team all-star honors at first base in baseball and was selected to play in all-state game. College: Redshirted freshman season. Will probably battle McCoy for backup role this fall. Has excellent size and very strong arm. Misc: Born 1-14-78 at Renton. Pre-med major. Planning career in sports medicine. Posted 3.48 GPA in high school. Has one sister.

Sean McCoy (QB, 6-3, 215, Jr., Everett)

High School: Graduated from Everett in 1994. Lettered in football (3), basketball (1), wrestling (1) and track-and-field (2). Played quarterback and linebacker in football. Team captain. College: Redshirted freshman season. Has been on squad past two seasons, but has not lettered. Misc: Born 11-8-75 at Kirkland. Business major. Has one brother and one sister. Posted 3.50 GPA in high school.

Running Backs

Tobi Gibson (RB, 5-10, 190, Fr., Tacoma - Spanaway Lake)

High School: Graduated from Spanaway Lake in 1996. Three-year letter winner in football. Played running back, slot and outside linebacker and also returned kicks. Team MVP. Rushed for 750 yards and also had 950 receiving yards. Two-time all-league OLB. College: Redshirted freshman year. Misc: Born 6-20-78 in Germany. Business major. Planning career in marketing. Has one brother.

Julian Hamm (RB, 5-9, 175, So., Des Moines - Mt. Rainier)

High School: Graduated from Mt. Rainier in 1995. Three-year letter winner in football. Also competed in basketball and track. Running back and defensive back in football. Led league in rushing (989 yards) and all-purpose running senior season to earn first team all-star honors. Honorable mention all-star as sophomore and junior. Team captain senior year. Nominated for all-state game, but didn't play because of an injury. College: Redshirted freshman year. Played backup role last season, rushing for 278 yards on 68 carries. Scored two touchdowns. Also caught nine passes for 53 yards. Got a lot of reps in spring as Murphy sat out drills because of knee injury. Has great body balance and sees holes well. Has excellent quickness. Misc: Born 12-31-75 at Spokane. Counseling major. Has one sister. Cousin (Lance Hamm) played basketball at Texas Christian.

Dan Murphy (RB, 6-2, 205, So., Royal City)

High School: Graduated from Royal City in 1995. Earned nine letters - three in football, two in basketball and four in baseball. Linebacker and running back in football. All-league in football, basketball and baseball. All-state and Team MVP on offense and defense in football. Played forward in basketball and first base, second base and third base in baseball. College: Redshirted freshman year. Was switched from tight end to running back last fall. Went on to lead team in rushing (761 yards). Also caught 22 passes for 172 yards. Ranked second on team in scoring with 60 points. Rushing total was the most in school history by a freshman. Had season-high 144 yards against Whitworth in season-opener. Netted 114 yards against Southern Oregon on Nov. 2. Missed most of final game of season and all of spring practice with knee injury. .Has ability to run over and also to outrun defensive players. Tough to bring down. Misc: Born 4-21-77 at Moses Lake. Agribusiness major. Plans to follow father in orchardist business. Posted 3.75 GPA in high school and won several academic scholarships. Was also involved in honor society and church youth group. Has one brother and one sister.

Kip Shepard (RB, 5-9, 185, So., Stanwood - Lakewood)

High School: Graduated from Lakewood High School in 1995. Earned nine letters - four in football, two in basketball and three in baseball. Running back and linebacker in football, guard in

basketball and shortstop in baseball. College: Redshirted freshman year and was on squad but did not letter last season. Carried the ball one time for a net two yards. Misc: Born 9-9-76 at Bellingham. Construction management major. Has one brother and two sisters.

Bobby Whitlow (RB, 5-9, 190, Fr., Yelm)

High School: Graduated from Yelm in 1996. Lettered in football (3), wrestling (3) and baseball (1). First team all-league running back and punter. Second team all-league outfielder in baseball. Lead team in hitting. Competed in district meet (as No. 2 seed at 178 pounds) in wrestling. College: Redshirted freshman season. Misc: Born 2-22-78 at Colville. Flight technology major. Wants to be airline pilot. Had 3.5 GPA in high school, winning two academic scholarships. Has one brother.

Slot Backs (H-Back)

Josh Woodard (Slot, 5-11, 185, Sr., Auburn)

High School: Graduated from Auburn High School in 1993. Lettered in football (3) and baseball (3). Played running back and free safety in football. All-league junior and senior season. Outfielder in baseball. College: Played defensive back in freshman season. Had six tackles, including four primaries. Switched to offense sophomore season. Started 13 games and caught 44 passes for 470 yards and three touchdowns. Had season-high eight catches against Pacific Lutheran. Ranked second on team in receiving last season catching 47 passes for 571 yards earning first team all-conference honors. Forty-seven catches is 10th best single-season total in school history. Caught 10 passes for 135 yards (both season team-highs) against Simon Fraser. Had eight catches for 100 yards against Southern Oregon. Ranks fifth in career receptions with 91 for 1,041 yards and seven touchdowns. . . Is a tough, physical player who likes contact. Has good hands and runs good routes. Misc: Born 11-19-74 at Decatur, Ala. Business Administration/marketing major. Posted 3.6 GPA in high school. Has one brother and two sisters. Married. Wife's name is Jodie. Has infant daughter, Shaley Kathleen Anne, who was born May 8.

Josh Sarpy (Slot, 5-5, 155, Jr., Oak Harbor)

High School: Graduated from Oak Harbor High School in 1995. Lettered in football (3), basketball (2), baseball (4) and wrestling (1). Played quarterback and defensive back in football. All-league kicker and quarterback. Played guard in basketball. All-league utility in baseball. Also earned all-state honors in baseball. Won district and regional championships and placed seventh in state meet in wrestling. College: Two-year letter winner in football. Saw considerable playing time at H-back position freshman season. Netted 42 yards on eight rushes. Caught five passes for 55 yards. Netted 52 yards on three rushes and also caught three passes for 34 yards last season. Is extremely quick. . . Redshirted freshman

season in baseball. Earned letter last spring. Played in 17 games, mostly as a courtesy runner. Misc: Born 3-29-77 in Arizona. Has one brother. Business administration major.

Tony Frank (WR, 6-0, 190, Sr., Clallam Bay - WWCC)

High School: Graduated from Clallam Bay in 1993. Lettered in football (2), basketball (4) and track (2). Played running back in football. Team MVP. Played guard in basketball and competed in high jump, triple jump and long jump in track. College: Played two seasons at Walla Walla CC. Caught 22 passes for 434 yards and six touchdowns sophomore year. Started nine of 10 games last fall for Wildcats. Caught 28 passes for 480 yards and six touchdowns. Averaged team-best 17.1 yards per catch, including long of 52. Caught four passes for 100 yards against Southern Oregon. . .Has excellent speed and has ability to go deep. Misc: Born 9-21-75 at Walla Walla. Law and justice major. Has one brother and one sister.

Davis Lura (WR, 6-0, 185, Sr., Stanwood)

High School: Graduated from Stanwood in 1993. Lettered in football (3) and basketball (3). Twice earned second team all-league defensive back honors. Second team all-league receiver junior season. First team all-league senior season. Team captain junior and senior seasons in basketball. College: On squad freshman season, but did not letter. Earned letter sophomore and junior seasons as backup wide receiver. Did not catch any balls sophomore year. Caught 11 passes for 73 yards last fall. Misc: Born 3-20-75 at Jamestown, N.D. Physical education major. Had 3.3 GPA in high school. High school activities included FBLA (Future Business Leaders of America). Father (Duey) played football and baseball at Mayville State. Cousin (Scott Boe) played baseball at North Dakota.

Ty Nunez (WR, 6-1, 180, So., Yakima - East Valley)

High School: Graduated from East Valley High School in 1995. Lettered in football (3) and basketball (2). Three-time all-league wide receiver and free safety. Also earned all-state honors. Played forward in basketball earning all-league honors. College: Redshirted freshman season. On squad, but did not letter last spring. Has good hands and runs good routes. Has deceptive speed. Misc: Born 11-12-76 at Yakima. Law enforcement major. High school activities included drama and public speaking. Has two brothers and five sisters.

Brett Rogers (WR, 5-8, 168, Jr., Yakima - Eisenhower)

High School: Graduated from Eisenhower High School in 1994. Lettered in football (2), baseball (2) and wrestling (3). Played wide receiver in football and outfield in baseball. Led team in receptions senior year with 27. College: Redshirted freshman

season. On squad, but did not letter past two seasons. Has shown vast improvement both in catching and running with football. Misc: Born 3-16-76 at Yakima. Elementary education major. High school activities included student council and student body treasurer. Father (Paul) played baseball at UW.

Ryan Seal (WR, 6-2, 190, So., Poulsbo - North Kitsap)

High School: Graduated from North Kitsap in 1995. Earned three letters each in football (3) and baseball (3). All-league split end and Academic award winner in football. Most Improved award winner as pitcher in baseball. College: Redshirted freshman year. Caught 18 passes for 186 yards and two touchdowns last season. Had eight catches for 87 yards in season finale against Eastern Oregon. . . .Has good speed and soft hands. Misc: Born 4-12-77 at Kennewick. Business major. Has four sisters. Posted 3.53 GPA in high school. Was on honor roll and Principal's List.

Lawrence (LT) Troutman (WR, 5-10, 176, Jr., St. Petersburg, Fla. - Santa Barbara)

High School: Graduated from Dixie Hollins High School in 1993. Lettered in football, basketball and track and field. Played wide receiver in football and point guard in baseball. Sprinter in track-and-field. College: Played football and competed in track-and-field at Santa Barbara City College. Played in 13 of CWU's 14 games during 1995 championship season. Caught 12 passes for 129 yards. Sat out 1996 season. Misc: Born 10-20-72 at St. Petersburg, Fla. Has two brothers and one sister.

Dolan Holt (TE, 6-2, 220, Sr., Enumclaw)

High School: Graduated from Enumclaw in 1993. Lettered in football (3), basketball (2) and baseball (2). First team all-league tight end. Team captain and first team all-league center in basketball. Second team all-league first baseman in baseball. College: Played backup role to three-time all-star Todd Murray past three seasons, starting a total of four games when Murray was hurt. Caught six passes for 86 yards freshman season. Started three games sophomore year catching 32 passes for 418 yards and one touchdown. Caught eight passes for 75 yards last season. . . .Was voted Outstanding Freshman award winner in 1994. Earned honorable mention all-league honors sophomore and junior seasons, despite playing backup role. Has excellent hands, perhaps the best on the team. Misc: Born 9-17-75 at Seattle. Has one sister. Leisure services major. Posted 3.1 GPA in high school winning two academic scholarships.

Andy Wagner (TE, 6-1, 210, Jr., Snohomish)

High School: Graduated from Snohomish High School in 1994. Lettered in football (3), basketball (2) and track (3). Played quarterback in football. Team captain award winner. Forward in basketball. Voted Captain and Most Inspirational award winner.

College: On squad in 1995. Earned letter last fall as No. 3 tight end. Will backup Holt this fall. Has good speed and might also be used as H-back.

Evan Ayres (OL, 6-2, 255, Jr., Bellingham - Sehome)

High School: Graduated from Sehome in 1994. Lettered in football (3) and track (4). All-conference offensive tackle junior and senior seasons. Competed in district meet in discus and javelin in track junior and senior years. College: Redshirted 1994 season. Earned letter last year as backup on offensive line freshman season. Started all 10 games as weakside guard last year. Next to Doll is strongest player on team. Is very intelligent player and team leader. Misc: Born 7-14-75 at Bellingham. Sports fitness major. Wants to be a personnel trainer. Posted 3.2 GPA in high school.

Josh Burgess (OT, 6-2, 260, So., Yakima - West Valley)

High School: Graduated from West Valley in 1995. Lettered in football (3), wrestling (1) and track-and-field (3). Twice first team all-league offense. Second team defense and first team defense junior and seniors seasons respectively. Played in all-state game. Team captain junior season. Placed seventh in discus (153-0) in Class AA state track-and-field meet junior season. High school career bests of 155-4 in discus and 52-10 1/2 in shot put. College: Redshirted freshman season. Started three games at strongside guard slot last season. Has quick feet and good size. Misc: Born 11-3-76 at Yakima. Law enforcement major. Posted 3.2 high school GPA. Has one brother.

Mark Doll (OT, 6-2, 250, Jr., Selah)

High School: Graduated from Selah in 1994. Lettered in football (3) and baseball. Played tight end and outside linebacker in football. First team all-league. Two-time captain and Best Defensive Lineman award winner. Played first base in baseball. Selected Athlete-of-the-Year. College: Is CWU's most experienced and best offensive lineman. Was switched from tight end line halfway through 1994 redshirt season. Has started 24 consecutive games at strongside tackle past two seasons. Helped lead Wildcats to No. 1 ranking in total offense in CFA each of past two seasons. Voted CWU's Outstanding Freshman award winner in 1995. Earned second team all-conference honors last year. Will be on of team leaders this falls. Perhaps is strongest player on team. Misc: Born 2-14-76 at Yakima. Law enforcement major. Has one sister. Uncles Jay Gilliam and Mike Ehliis played football at CWU and YVC, respectively.

Jason Frederick (OT, 6-1, 250, Jr., Raymond - Willapa Valley)

High School: Graduated from Willapa Valley in 1992. Lettered in football (3), basketball (2) and track (3). Receiver and defensive

end in football. Inspirational and Coaches award winner. Played guard in basketball. College: Attended Centralia CC prior to enrolling at CWU. Redshirted 1994 season. On squad in 1995. Earned letter last fall in backup role. Might challenge for starting berth at weakside tackle slot. Misc: Born 8-26-74 at South Bend, Wash. Education major. Has one brother and two sisters. Uncle (Gary Frederick) is CWU's athletic director and women's softball coach. Father (Mike) and uncle (Steve) competed in cross country at CWU. Father also served university as women's assistant basketball coach in late 1980s.

Jim Hyde (C, 6-1, 250, Jr., Bremerton - WWCC)

High School: Graduated from Bremerton High School in 1993. Three-year letter winner in football. Earned first team all-league honors. Voted Outstanding Lineman and Most Improved award winner. College: Played center for two seasons at Walla Walla CC. Voted Lineman of the Year. Misc: Born 6-3-75 at Bremerton. Undecided on major. Has one sister.

Chris Scheer (OT, 6-1, 250, Fr., Tacoma - Wilson)

High School: Graduated from Wilson High School in 1996. Three-year letter winner in football. First team all-conference offensive lineman senior season. College: Redshirted freshman season. Could challenge for starting slot at tackle this fall. Misc: Born 11-28-77 at Tacoma. Communications major. Wants to be sports broadcaster. Had 3.61 GPA in high school twice earning All-Narrows League academic honors. Served as senior class vice president and student representative in high school. Has two brothers and one sister.

Robert Thomas (OT, 6-1, 240, So., Port Angeles)

High School: Graduated from Port Angeles High School in 1995. Lettered in football (3) and track (1). All-league center in football. Competed in shot put and discus in track. College: After redshirting freshman year, earned letter last fall. Handled long snapping duties as well as playing backup role on offensive line. Will contend for starting slot at weakside tackle. Misc: Born 9-25-76 at Port Angeles. Physical education major. Planning to be PE teacher. High school activities included school newspaper and band. Has one brother.

Non-athletic activities have included community service, Junior ROTC and church. Has three sisters.

Jake Conley (DT, 6-0, 245, Fr., Morton)

High School: Graduated from Morton in 1996. Lettered in football (4), baseball (2) and track-and-field (2). Also competed in basketball. Team captain in football junior and senior seasons. Earned first team all-state honors on defense and second team on offense senior season. Played in all-state game. First team all-conference on offense and second team on defense junior campaign. Played outfield freshman and sophomore seasons before switching to track junior year. Most improved award winner junior year. Competed in state meet in shot put senior season. College: Did not turn out for football last year. Has good quickness and quck feet and will be a factor at defensive tackle this fall. Misc: Born 11-9-78 at Boise, Idaho. Business administration major. Posted outstanding 3.73 GPA in high school. Competed on school's Knowledge Bowl team and was also active in Honor Society and FBLA (Future Business Leaders). Scott Morgan (DT, 6-0, 245, Jr., Mt. Vernon)

College: Three-year letterman. Had seven tackles and recovered one fumble freshman season before redshirting in 1994. Moved to defensive line and played key backup role sophomore season, finishing with 19 tackles, including 13 primaries and three quarterback sacks for losses of 15 yards. Started nine games and was top tackler among defensive lineman with 40 stops, including 25 primary tackles. Ranked second on team in quarterback sacks. . .Has good quickness and strength and will be leader of defensive line this fall. Misc: Born 8-12-74 at Olympia. Spanish and Education major.
