STUDENTS NOT CLASSIFIED IN 1 OR 2 ABOVE MUST CONTACT THE REGISTRAR'S OFFICE FOR ADMISSION.

3. All students planning to complete a degree program or a fifth year and a standard certificate, must apply for admission and complete the following steps:
 - a. Submit page one of the standard application for admission form.
 - b. Have each institution you have previously attended submit official transcripts directly to the Registrar's Office.
 - c. Upon compliance with the above requirements you will be notified of your admission and this admission slip must be presented at the time of registration.
 - d. All special and transient students, those not planning to complete a degree program or the fifth year and standard certificate, must submit:
 1. Standard application for admission, page one.
 2. An acceptance slip indicating transient, sent upon receipt of above application. This acceptance slip must be presented to begin registration.
