Review Minutes of November 5, 2009 - Joe moved to accept the minutes. Nathan seconded and motion was approved.

Old Business

09-10.03 Double degree proposal – Dr. Gries gave an overview of what is currently happening in the Music department with regards to this proposal. The core courses are much the same, but the education sequence is different and would have 9 additional credits that would not count toward the Music Ed degree. Currently Dr. Gries writes 3-4 letters per year requesting that student receive their second degree. It has always been supported. His proposal would add language that would require a student to have at least 60 different credits that are not included in the other degree. Joe moved to accept Dr. Gries proposal to add language to 5.9-10.2 Motion was seconded and approved. Janet will submit this language to the Executive Committee.
