#### EXECUTIVE SESSION

#### CAMPUS CLIMATE TASK FORCE REPORT RECOMMENDATIONS

President Nelson reviewed university response to the Campus Climate Task Force Report recommendations and indicated that our focus is on the whole institution. Discussions are occurring in many units and the level of awareness of climate issues is heightened. Implementation of training opportunities for all supervisors is being explored as well as ideas for providing the services of an ombudsman. Facilities Management is being audited so issues in that unit can be addressed.

Recruitment of individuals to fill administrative vacancies provides opportunities to include climate issues in interviews, ensuring that candidates are sensitive to gender and ethnicity and are team oriented. Institutional pride must be developed if we are to rebuild a positive environment. Results of our efforts to create a more positive working and learning environment must be identifiable.

Realizing its opportunity to foster a spirit of understanding and unity on the campus, the Board will meet with various university constituencies each fall.
