At the request of the Board, Ms. Belcher presented an overview of trust lands' management. She explained how the Department of Natural Resources manages the trust lands, how those lands were created at statehood, where they are located, and projections for future revenue. Normal school trust lands were reviewed and a draft asset stewardship plan to guide future decisions about assets was presented.

Following Ms. Belcher's presentation, the trustees reviewed a draft work plan for the year and focused on Board meeting process. Major items will be reviewed at one meeting with action occurring at a subsequent meeting. Informational presentations on the Board themes are scheduled for specific meetings with input on the same theme planned for a subsequent meeting date. Input will be requested from the constituency groups participating in the October 9, 1997 retreat sessions.

Action Items

Unanticipated snowfall during last winter's storms damaged the Recreation Center beyond repair. The facility is entirely unusable due to the failure of both roof and wall structural elements. In the interest of public safety, \$10,000 from the Infrastructure Savings capital project has been authorized for this action by the Office of Financial Management.

Motion 97:37: Trustee Woods moved, seconded by Trustee Glover, that the Board of Trustees of Central Washington University authorize the demolition of the Recreation Center (building #014). Motion carried.

Board of Trustees Discussion and Action Items

Mrs. Chaplin reported on yesterday's Board retreat sessions with cross-sectional university groups. Over sixty people met with the trustees to focus on the 1997-98 Board Themes. Participating individuals expressed pride in Central and shared their commitment, vision for the future, creative approaches, and sense of community.

A Board work schedule for the year, including dates of theme presentations, was reviewed and discussed. Information on the five Board themes will be presented at designated regular meetings or study sessions, with input on each theme received at the next meeting(s). Board support for diversity (Theme 4) will be reaffirmed by resolution in November. Major issues will be reviewed at one meeting with action occurring at a subsequent meeting. Following some modification to Theme 3, the themes will be adopted formally in November.

It was suggested that departments/units receive direction on integration of themes into their strategic planning efforts.

President's Report and Action Items

Reports

Academic Affairs

In summarizing his written report to the Board, Provost Dauwalder reviewed highlights of the fall faculty meeting, ABET (Accreditation Board for Engineering and Technology) accreditation status for our Electronics Engineering Technology and Mechanical Engineering Technology programs, student awards, recent Higher Education Coordinating Board approval of the CWU Accountability Plan, appointment of Dr. Libby Street as executive director of our NASC (Northwest Association of Schools and Colleges) accreditation efforts, distance education multiple-site courses; approval of a proposal to offer the CWU Master of Science program in Organizational Development at the CWU SeaTac Center; overview of predesign studies at the CWU Centers at SeaTac and Yakima; and a field-based/performance-based pilot Master Teacher program in Wenatchee.

Business and Financial Affairs

Vice President Nasser reported that the university is finalizing the fire protection contract with the City of Ellensburg. The revised contract is based on a university/city square footage ratio and will include the Biology/Chemistry Facility and Black Hall. Mr. Nasser also reviewed the Major and Minor Capital Report and mentioned that information concerning capital projects can be accessed on our web site.

Student Affairs

Vice President Shumate stated that 1,919 students are housed in residence halls this quarter and that university apartments are full with waiting lists. Revenues have been impacted as the residence halls have fewer double occupancies. Residence hall programming will be adjusted to compensate. October is domestic violence awareness month for the state of Washington. Training is available to housing managers. Plans have been implemented for a number of education and prevention efforts to address concerns regarding the increase in underage drinking among students.

University Advancement

Vice President Young briefed the trustees on CWU Foundation activities and university private

Faculty Senate

Chair Rob Perkins discussed current Faculty Senate activity including a salary equity study, merit evaluation, and examination of the election process for Senate chair. Grade inflation, distance education, and other issues affecting faculty need to be examined.

Ms. Amy Gillespie, President of the Board of Directors, Associated Students of Central Washington University, reviewed BOD response to recent hate mail. Criteria have been established to ensure that Service and Activity Fees are equitably distributed and benefit all students who contribute, including those attending at CWU centers.

Association Chair Jen Gray reported that the group recently held its first meeting and would be forming committees and establishing goals.
